

Information Integrity — The Case of NDAP's Newsletter

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Since the late 19th century, no one has ever questioned the accuracy, accountability, and integrity of information on newspapers. Nowadays, the newspapers are still gained people's trust on their news; the professional procedure to handle, to produce information into news, no matter what is in paper or electronic form. However, there are some conflicts rising in the production of electronic newspapers because of people's different perception on the nature of the Internet and there's a gap of communication between information providers and information producers though the professional procedure is still the same.

The changing is mainly caused by the Internet. But, some old problems within the process of news production become salience, even cause a difficulty for a professional conduct. This paper is going to address all of these problems and the change by the case study of the National Digital Archives Program's Newsletter (published by the National Digital Archives Program in Taiwan), focused on some theoretical and pragmatic aspects, also with recommendations for information integrity of a newsletter on the Internet.
