Dr. Jieh Hsiang is the University Librarian and a Distinguished Professor in Computer Science of the National Taiwan University. He is also a Research Fellow of the Institute of Information Sciences of the Academia Sinica. Starting 1996, his research interests gradually moved from automated deduction to digital libraries and archives. He actively participated and was partially responsible for several of the large digitization projects of Taiwan, including the first phase of the National Digital Archives Program of NSC and the National Cultural Heritage Repository of the Council for Cultural Affairs. He has also been in charge of the digitization effort at the National Taiwan University.

Dr. Hsiang has written extensively on issues concerning automated deduction, logics for programs, digital archives/libraries, and digital resource creation and management in university libraries. His most recent focus is on creating a digital research environment for historians.
