In previous years, he was Managing Director of MCNC Grid and Data Center Services in North Carolina; Sun's Senior Director of Grid Computing in Menlo Park, CA; President, CEO, and CTO of several successful start-up companies (Genias, Gridware, among others), and professor of mathematics and computer science at the University of Applied Sciences in Regensburg, Germany.
