

Possibility of name of a place ontology
-- That centers on old calendar document of Japan --

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The origin of the name of a place is artificial. It can be said that the idea of each occasion people was reflected.
(The location of very a lot of name of a place origin theory stories in ancient Japan!)

We had made the index database of 'Dainihon-Chimeijisho (The Dictionary of Place Names in Greater Japan)' that Tougo Yoshida completed spending about 13 years for oneself.

Furthermore, the calendar day data base of one million days was made. The other 'Kojiruien' database and the construction of the classics concept database (ontology-database) are advanced.

If these knowledge resources are used, the world based on the completely different way of thinking from the former will be cultivated.

For example, considering "water", the following thing can be illustrated. That is, of what kind of view of the world are Japanese people reminded from water from ancient times? Or what kind of language is there in the name of a place name relevant to water? Or a bridge, a lake, etc. are that what kind of name has been attached to the thing in connection with "water" etc.

Furthermore, when GIS and calendar day information are added to such information, what happens or it is excited at the possibility of the knowledge discovery.
