

Michael Buckland is Emeritus Professor in the School of Information, University of California, Berkeley, and Co-Director of the Electronic Cultural Atlas Initiative. After degrees in History at Oxford and Librarianship at Sheffield University, he worked as a librarian in England and in the USA. Past positions include Dean of the School of Library and Information Studies at Berkeley, Assistant Vice President for Library Plans and Policies in the University of California systemwide administration, and President of the American Society for Information Science and Technology. He has published extensively on library services, organization of information, and the history of documentation.
