

Jieh Hsiang is a Distinguished Professor in Computer Science at the National Taiwan University (NTU) and a Research Fellow of the Institute of Information Systems of the Academia Sinica. He is also the Director of the Research Center of Digital Humanities of NTU, and is leading the digitization effort of that university. He was the University Librarian of NTU between 2002 and 2008, and was a full professor in Computer Science at the State University of New York at Stony Brook before returning to Taiwan in 1993.

He received two Outstanding Research Awards from the National Science Council of Taiwan, one Test-of-Time Award from IEEE, and one Academia/Industry Collaboration Award from the Ministry of Education, all for his research work in computer science. His service as the University Librarian resulted in two Distinguished Service Awards, one from the Taiwanese Library Association and one from the National Taiwan University.

His current research interest focuses mainly on incorporating digital archives and information technology into humanities, especially Taiwanese history, research.
