

Pierre-Yves Manguin is a professor at the Ecole française d'Extrême-Orient (EFEO, French School of Asian Studies), and teaches at the Ecole des Hautes Etudes en Sciences Sociales (EHESS, Paris). His research focuses on history and archaeology of the coastal states and trade networks of Southeast Asia. He has lead archaeological work in Indonesia and Vietnam and published on themes related to history and archaeology of Southeast Asia, the Indian Ocean and South China Sea, and on the archaeology of Funan (Vietnam), of Srivijaya (South Sumatra), and of Tarumanagara (West Java). He coordinates the "Ancient Khmer Landscapes" programme, which is building an online corpus of the archaeological and epigraphic data deposited at the EFEO.
