

Ruth Mostern is an Assistant Professor and member of the Founding Faculty in the School of Social Sciences, Humanities and Arts at the University of California, Merced. She is a specialist in the history of imperial China with a particular focus on the relationship between spatial organization and state power. Her book, *Dividing the Realm in Order to Govern: The Spatial Organization of State Power in Song China (960-1276 CE)* will be published by the Harvard University Asia Center in 2010. She has also conducted research and developed exemplar projects in the field of digital gazetteers for history, focusing in particular on the need for gazetteer databases to represent historical events and their relationships. Her *Digital Gazetteer of the Song Dynasty* has just been released, and her Rethinking Timelines research initiative is ongoing.
