Shu-Jiun (Sophy) Chen received her M.A. degrees in Library and Information Management from the Information Studies Department of University of Sheffield, UK in 1997, and now a PhD candidate in the Department and Graduate Institute of Library and Information Science at the National Taiwan University.

Ms Chen has been with the Computing Centre, Academia Sinica, Taiwan, where she is an Information Analyst since August 1, 1998. Ms Chen currently serves as Program Manager of Program Office of the Taiwan e-Learning and Digital Archives Program (TELDAP, <http://teldap.tw/en/>), and also the Co-PI of the Metadata Architecture and Application Team (MAAT, <http://metadata.teldap.tw/index-eng.html>) of Research & Development of Technology Division of the TELDAP, sponsored by the National Science Council, Taiwan. Besides, she is also the Chair of the MCN Taiwan (Museum Computer Network, Taiwan Chapter) Special Interest Group on Standards (Standards SIG, http://mcntw.teldap.tw/en/groups/sig_standards.php). She recently initiated the Research Project of AAT (Art & Architecture Thesaurus) in Chinese with Getty Research Institute.

Her research interests include digital libraries, metadata and knowledge organization systems, and human information behavior. She has published over 20 articles in refereed journals and conference proceedings.
