### **Dr. Jough-Tai Wang**

Dr. Jough-Tai Wang is a Professor at Dept. of Atmospheric Sciences, National Central University (NCU), and also the Executive Secretary of IGBP China-Taipei National Committee. His major field of expertise is in the climate dynamics, numerical weather prediction, global change and sustainable development related study.

Dr. Wang received his bachelor degree in Atmospheric Physics from NCU, Taiwan, and MS and PHD degrees from Oregon State University, USA (also in Atmospheric Sciences). He did his post-doc research at Texas A& M University and later joined the Dept. of Atmospheric Sciences of NCU at 1988 as Associate Professor. He was promoted to the rank of Full Professor at 1992. Between 1992-1994, he was the Chief Editor of "Terrestrial, Atmosphere and Ocean (TAO)" Journal, Published by Chinese Geosciences Union located in Taipei. Dr. Wang also served in various positions within NCU which included the Atmospheric Sciences Department Chair (1996-1999), and Director, Center for Environmental Studies (2002-2008). Within National Science Council (NSC), he served as the Director of Earth Sciences Research Promotion Center (2000--2002) and Coordinator of Global Change Research Discipline (2004--2008).
