Professor Huang received his PhD in urban and community design from the Graduate Institute of Building and Planning, National Taiwan University. He specializes in practical and research work in architecture, community design, and urban design. He is a veteran activist in spatial issues faced by Taiwanese cities during the process of urban and social development, such as historical conservation, ecological sustainability, the right of access to the city, public art, and social housing.

Prof. Huang established the Community Action Team, Tamshui(CATT) in 1993 to practice community/environmental redevelopment. In addition to focusing efforts on various issues of urban development, Professor Huang has played leading roles in local community actions in historical Tamshui (such as environmental education, citizen activism, and local placemaking), while emphasizing community involvement in the process. For years he also has helped the local government in planning and implementing projects of urban preservation and innovation.
