

The Fieldwork Real Time Report System Based on Data Emailing and Its Application

"Fieldwork real time report system" is easy and small system to public and to science-interpret research works for people. It starts as a test service from Research Institute for Languages and Cultures of Asia and Africa, Tokyo University of Foreign Studies. Complex or unfamiliar procedure is not employed to post reports because researchers should easily use this system on field. A picture and its caption can be sent as attached file and e-mail text. Some command can also be sent. The system gets information about longitude and latitude of the picture location by geotag in the picture data or explicit description in the e-mail. Period of report displaying term can be changed by system configuration as the initial condition or by user configuration for each report. Report displaying part of the system is available. The report receive part currently starts to operate the service in closed members for test. This system is expected to connect directly researchers on their fields and society. The technical term and results in operation will be discussed in the session.
